The Substance Abuse Counselor works as a member of a multi-disciplinary team that provides therapeutic and rehabilitative services, counseling, case management and integrated dual-diagnostic treatment. The team works to address all treatment needs, including crisis management, substance abuse treatment, medication management, physical health treatment, mental health treatment, accessing benefits and entitlements, and other supportive services.

RESPONSIBILITY: Under the direct supervision of the Clinical Supervisor, the Counselor carries the responsibility of adequately developing and maintaining a helpful and therapeutic relationship with the members of his/her caseload. Additionally, the Counselor must utilize to the greatest extent possible the internal and external referral resources available to RFS.

- Bachelors in related field, minimum of high school degree with substance abuse experience may also be considered.
