MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES & amp: VIOLENCE PREVENTION

Counseling, Case Management, Intensive Case Management serve clients ages 3 and up, with more than 95% of our clients coming from low-income families. Trained clinicians develop personalized treatment plans, engage clients, their families, and identify support structures to achieve their integrated behavioral health goals.

SUPPORTIVE HOUSING – THE LAVERNGE HOUSE – TRANSITIONAL LIVING PROGRAM (TLP)

This stable family environment provides youth a place to call home, more than a bed and food, but a place of healthy relationships, trust, consistent and unconditional support and mentorship, cultural connection, and intense educational, social, and therapeutic services. Living here is the beginning of a positive journey towards self-sufficiency and living on there own in the real world.

AFTER SCHOOL CARE – TO THE MOON ARTS & DUCATION Serving youth ages 6-12 from low-income families in Humboldt Park. Every year, our Afterschool Program organizes a talent show for the children and their families.

SUBSTANCE USE TREATMENT - WALKING THE PATH OF RECOVERY WITH OUR CLIENTS

Our outpatient substance use program provides tools and guidance to help clients better understand addiction and define their own path to recovery. We are dedicated to giving our clients compassionate care in all areas of our specialty, including counseling, MAR (Medication Assisted Recovery), and Case Management.

PRE-APPRETICESHIP PROGRAM

We've partnered with the State of Illinois to bring the Illinois Works Pre-Apprenticeship program to our community. The program is designed to increase the number of qualified construction and building trades apprentices who are women, people of color, veterans, and prepares them with on the job skill set training and resources to enter full apprenticeship programs on their way to careers in the construction and building trades.

VIOLENCE PREVENTION REIMAGINE

This program provides a comprehensive approach to public safety addressing gun violence in our communities to address the spike in firearm violence. We utilize evidence based programs to engage individuals at risk of firearm violence, including street outreach, case management, and victim advocacy.
